Hints to make the transition to reusable bags

1. Always add bags on the first line of your shopping list

2. Most households should have 8-10 reusable bags

- Reusable bags can be purchased at local grocery stores, clothing stores, thrift shops and online retailers

3. Make sure to wash or wipe down your reusable bags regularly

4. Put a sticky note on your dash to remind you to bring your bags into the store with you

5. Find sturdy cardboard boxes to carry your groceries

6. Use bags that you actually like to carry

7. Store bags strategically

- After use, place bags back into your car
- Put bags in convenient locations like next to the door, in your purse or backpack
- Fold them up and store them all in one bag
