Permit for Use of Beer in Public Parks

This permit is strictly and only for the consumption of BEER and does not allow the selling of beer.
A \$15 Processing Fee and \$100 Damage Deposit required.

Table with fields: Name of Organization, Telephone, Name of Representative, Date of Birth, Address, Park/Pavilion to be Used, Number of Guests, Date of Park Use, Hours of Use.

I understand that

- I must remain on the premises with a copy of this permit for review by any police officer during the time the permit is effective.
I further understand that the park and/or facility used by our group are to be left in a state of cleanliness and repair.
In addition, I am aware of Section 66-32 of Arvada's City Code which states that public parks and facilities shall be open until 11pm and that this permit is valid from 11am to 9pm on the day requested.

Conditions of Issuance

- I am 21 years of age on or before the date I am requesting this permit.
I agree to remain on the premises at all times while beer is being consumed. I agree to be responsible for the actions of members of my group and for any damage they might cause at the park site or facility
There will be no loud noise or violent conduct that would infringe on the reasonable privacy of individuals in the park or the surrounding areas of the park.
I understand that beer must not be transported or consumed in glass containers.
If the park site is left with excessive trash or is damaged, I understand that the damage deposit of \$100 will be used to cover the cost of cleanup or to repair the damaged property and that I am responsible for any additional costs.
Pursuant to CRS31-15-401 (1)(E) I understand persons operating under this permit must obey all lawful orders of any duly sworn officer of the law regarding violations of law.
