2/17/2022

7 a.m. - Crews continue to treat roads and park paths this morning. Don't forget that the [Arvada Municipal Code](#) requires that snow, ice and slush be removed from sidewalks within 24 hours after the end of a snowfall.

2/16/2022

5 p.m. - The Snow Team has deployed 15 plow trucks and operators this afternoon, beginning at 3:00 pm. Snow is expected until the early morning hours tomorrow and temps will drop into the teens. Currently, roads are becoming slick and icy conditions will continue through the rush hour. If you are traveling this evening, please use caution.

3:50 p.m. - Snow is coming down quickly this afternoon. Arvada Police Department put the city on accident alert. Unless the accident involves someone injured, the cars cannot be moved, a driver involved is under the influence of drugs/alcohol or a driver cannot provide insurance information, you should make an [online report](#) within 24 hours.

5 a.m. - The National Weather Service [has declared a Winter Storm Warning](#) for late this afternoon and tonight for the Foothills and I-25 Corridor.
