

March 16 Snow Event

3/17/2022: Snow removal operations have concluded as of 3:30 pm. All snow routes are in good shape.

3/17/2022: As of 7:00 am the day shift began snow removal operations. It continues to snow with much of it melting quickly on the roadways. Most of the weather services are predicting the snow will diminish this afternoon. Presently we have 9 trucks deployed throughout the City.

3/16/2022: At 11:30 pm, we have begun a full deployment of 15 plow trucks and operators. Heavy, wet snow is expected through the night and into tomorrow.

From the National Weather Service:

- Snow expected late Wednesday afternoon through Thursday evening.
- The heaviest snow amounts are expected in the foothills, Palmer Divide and over the mountains east of the divide.
- A rain snow transition will occur for the urban corridor, foothills and eastern plains Wednesday evening.
- Snow cover roads for late Wednesday night into Thursday evening.
